

Child Health staff is able to assist you in applying for the *hawk-i* and Title 19 (Medicaid) program for your child. Staff will assist you in determining which program your child may qualify for and completing the appropriate application. For assistance please contact Rachel Cecil or Diane Ellis at 1-800-472-8711.

Hawk-i is health care coverage for uninsured children under the age of 19.

To qualify, a child must live in Iowa and:

- Be under 19 years old
- Have no other health insurance
- Be a citizen of the United States or a qualified alien
- Be in a family that meets the *hawk-i* income limits
- Cannot be the dependent of a State of Iowa employee
- Children who qualify for Medicaid cannot get *hawk-i*

These rates go into effect for any application received on or after March 1, 2011 with an effective start date of April 1, 2011

If your family's yearly countable income is in the blue, and you do not qualify for Medicaid, your children may be able to get FREE coverage under hawk-i.

If your family's yearly countable income is in the red, your children may be able to get hawk-i for \$10-\$20 per child per month. No family pays more than \$40 per month.
