Maternal Health Families in Jasper and Poweshiek Counties:

Marion County will no longer be providing Maternal Health services in your county after September 30, 2022. To ensure that you can easily continue to receive maternal health services, your maternal health records are being transferred to your new provider, Mid-Iowa Community Action. These services may have included oral health services, such as oral screens and fluoride varnish.

This does NOT change your Medicaid benefits, Medicaid managed care provider assignment (Amerigroup, Iowa Total Care) or your dental managed care provider assignment (MCNA, Delta Dental of Iowa).

Beginning October 1, 2022, Mid-Iowa Community Action will provide maternal health services for pregnant women of any age. These services may include:

- Health education and support
- Help locating a doctor or dentist
- Help making doctor appointments
- Help finding health care coverage
- Social support and guidance
- Nutrition education
- Home visits before and after the baby is born
- Dental screens and fluoride varnish applications
- Depression screening
